#### PROACTIVE PATROL EFFORTS:

- 1. Extra holiday patrols in the area of Monte Vista Crossings
  - October 2016 began the launch of a series of Holiday Safety videos, 2 of those videos were specifically addressing auto break ins in the area of Monte Vista Crossings
  - When compared to the same time frame for 2015, October 1st through December 31st 2016 had a **decrease of 25%** of auto break ins for Monte Vista Crossings
- 2. 24 people graduated the Citizens Academy graduated on November 21st after completing 11 weeks of course work
