SPECIAL DEPLOYMENT EFFORTS:

- Coffee with the Chief, May 19, 2018—Chief Amirfar hosted another Coffee with the Chief event. This event is open to the community to come and address any questions or concerns they have about Turlock directly with the Chief of Police.
- In May, Special Investigations Unit (SIU) assisted the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office with a human trafficking operation that let to 11 arrests at a local motel.
- In May, 7 Downtown Overtime Extra Patrol shifts were worked. Officers are allowed to sign-up to work non-mandatable overtime shifts to provide extra patrols, specifically to downtown and city parks to address City Ordinance issues, illegal nuisance behaviors, and other criminal violations.
- Daily, the Traffic Safety Unit patrols school areas during morning and afternoon traffic for extra traffic enforcement to ensure the safety of students.
- Rape Aggression Defense (RAD) course hosted in partnership with CSU Stanislaus Police Department concluded after 2 full training days, 13 participants completed the course.

ANIMAL SERVICES & PET OF THE MONTH:

- During March, Animal Services Officers visited 136 residents for pet license enforcement.




